Recreating the natural esthetics has been one of the most challenging targets in implant therapy. Prosthetically driven surgery and applying predictable GBR protocols have helped to ensure optimal three-dimensional placement for implants, however achieving perfect soft tissue aesthetics in more complex cases is still elusive.

In Day 1 of this program, Egon will demonstrate with case-series photographs, and multiple videos, the various peri-plastic surgical techniques for preserving the alveolar ridge post-extraction, augmenting the tissues at the time of implant surgery, and regenerating the tissues after implant

placement - the so called "implant aesthetic rescue" procedures. Egon will also address highly aesthetic restorations and provide insight into his experience and use of CAD CAM and metal-free abutments and crowns - how these materials can be used to improve treatment outcomes.

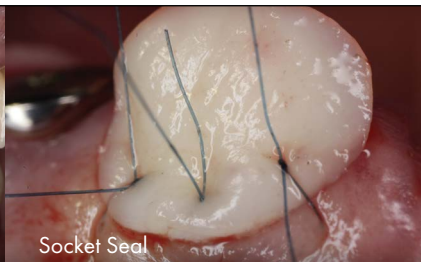
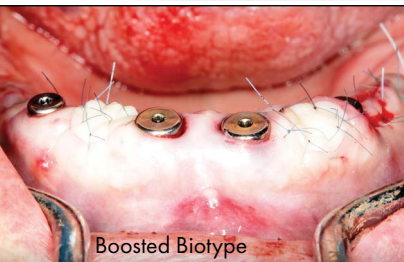
The workshop on Day 2 will focus on teaching attendees how to do these fine grafting and perio-plastic procedures utilising the pig mandible model.

- How to harvest a CT graft.
- How to increase the band of keratinized gingiva with a free gingival graft.
- How to optimize the keratinized tissue around an implant during uncovering.
- How to create a root contour buccally of an implant by doing a pouch procedure.
- How to boost the biotype simultaneously with implant placement.
- How to do root-coverage on multiple recessions with a tunneling technique
- Correct incision protocol during implant placement to preserve the papilla
- Suturing techniques for improved soft tissue results



Dr Egon Euwe is one of the finest clinicians in the world in implant dentistry. He obtained his Dental Degree in Holland in 1982, and from 1986, he specialised into the new field of oral implantology. Egon later trained with Dr Sascha Jovanovic at UCLA and together they present much of the gIDE Master Implant Programs. Egon is a Member of the European Academy of Esthetic Dentistry (EAED), European Association of Osseointegration (EAO), and worked in the Department of Periodontology at Milan University, researching resorption of newly formed bone. Egon's clinical ability in the field of perio-plastics, tissue grafting and ridge preservation is legendary and he is a consultant and educator for several implant companies. Egon's practice is limited to implant dentistry and is located in Lurago d'Erba, near the shores of Lake Como in Italy.
