



# TREATMENT PLANNING

IN EVERYDAY PRACTICE - *From single teeth to the complex case*

## Day One: Lecture

This one day lecture program will be divided into two parts. The first section will deal with treatment planning decisions for individual teeth - what type of restoration is best suited for restoring each tooth. When can a tooth be filled, and when does it need a crown or an onlay?

The second half of the program will address the mouth as a whole so that when multiple teeth are worn, broken down or missing and drifting or over-eruption has occurred, the clinician will learn how to assess the present bite, vertical dimension and smile design to guide them through the treatment planning process.

What you will learn:

- When to do a direct or indirect composite
- When to do a composite or progress to an onlay or crown
- When to do a veneer or when the tooth has to be crowned
- Indications for when a post is needed and what types suit which teeth
- Principles of aesthetic assessment and smile design
- Diagnostic records, and "try-in" of the planned changes to a smile
- Multidisciplinary treatment planning
- Case presentation - how to present your treatment plan
